For times when health concerns are urgent or unplanned, the Mobile Community Health clinic is available during the week in scheduled locations throughout the county, without an appointment. A Nurse Practitioner (NP) will make a brief assessment and recommend treatment options including follow-up care at your Primary Care Physician's office. Our Centreville Clinic and Bridge Healthcare Pharmacy are available to those who do not have a medical home.
